The new forms include joint doctoral courses, joint research seminars, visits for the purpose of researching and teaching, exchange of teachers, joint research projects, and oversea internship programmes.</p> <p>The “ECI-PUIIL Collaboration Project” intends to facilitate the collaboration between the two leading Institutes in international law in both countries in order to enhance cooperation in the field of education which have an impact on both China and Finland and be of relevance to international legal practices in both countries.</p>
<b>Partners</b>  Peking University Institute of International Law (PUIIL)	<p>The second cycle of legal training in international law provides legal training that transcends the difference between the legal systems, thus providing lawyers with knowledge of the respective national legal systems as well as of international legal issues. Students in the second cycle of legal training in international law could gain legal practice not only in cross border transactions but also in the other country. The “ECI-PUIIL Collaboration Project” has its objective to provide the opportunity for students to experience legal practice in another country, namely, students from Finland to experience legal practice in China, and students from China in Finland.</p>
