In our project, we will on the one hand build a novel platform of legal studies collaboration and further strengthen the development of social work collaboration between Finland and China. We believe that shifting the focus from the conventional sectorial teaching and studies on regulatory system or social security system (social work) to an interrelated holistic framework will greatly enhance our understanding of the particular challenges modern societies face. We are predominantly interested in understanding not only how these sectors (legal and regulatory framework and social work) develop per se, but how the regulatory environment and social work shape and condition each other and are conditioning the current challenges contemporary societies are facing.</p>
